Bus Routes

From the town centre the buses numbered 1, 5, 7, 11 and 23 can be caught and the bus stop required is Broadwater church, the fare for a single is £1.65. The Broadwater church bus stop is approx. 10 minute walk to and from The Charmandean. To the town centre buses 1 and 23 go direct to the town and buses 5 and 7 go via Worthing Central Station. Number 11 stops around 5pm and a night bus is available once an hour after 8pm. Journeys via the train station take approx. 15–20 mins depending on traffic, journeys direct to the town centre take 10-15 minutes depending on traffic.

Train Routes

Worthing central station is managed by Southern Rail and trains can be caught to London Victoria and London Bridge (running approx. every half hour) Journey time is around 1hour 30 mins. Trains can also be caught to Littlehampton, Portsmouth, Chichester, Southampton, Eastbourne and Brighton.
